## CALL TO CONVENTION

On behalf of the Right Reverend Charles G. vonRosenberg, Bishop of the diocese, it is with great pleasure that I, as the Secretary of the Convention, issue the Call to Convention for the Annual Convention of The Episcopal Church in South Carolina, to be held March 8-9, 2013, at Grace Episcopal Church in Charleston, South Carolina.

The Bishop has designated a theme for this Convention: “To Love and Serve the Lord.” This will be a time of fellowship and celebration for The Episcopal Church in South Carolina, and also one in which we hope to accomplish a great deal of work.

We are pleased to welcome as our preacher for the Convention Eucharist the Right Reverend J. Neil Alexander, Dean of the School of Theology at the University of the South and formerly Bishop of Atlanta.

The schedule for the Convention will be:

**Friday, March 8:** Choral Eucharist at 7:00 p.m., with Bishop Alexander preaching, followed by a reception

**Saturday, March 9:** Check-in begins at 7:30 a.m., with breakfast available; general business session convenes at 9:00 a.m. Lunch will be served.

We are asking each delegation to submit one registration packet and payment for your entire group. The cost will be \$50 per person for lay delegates, clergy delegates, and clergy with seat and voice. Guest registration will be \$30. These fees include Convention materials, the Friday reception, and breakfast and lunch on Saturday. All registration materials must be submitted no later than Friday, March 1.
