The Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of South Carolina (“Diocese of South Carolina”) and The Trustees of The Protestant Episcopal Church in South Carolina (“Trustees”), a South Carolina Corporate Body, hereby move this Court, pursuant to the provisions of Rule 65(b) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedures, for an Order restraining the Defendant, its officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys and those persons in active concert or participation with them from assuming, using, or adopting the names of the Diocese of South Carolina and its emblems as well as its registered names and seal and any names resembling the name and style of the Diocese of South Carolina for any purpose whatsoever, including:

- holding themselves out to be the Diocese of South Carolina;
- opening bank accounts in the name of the Diocese of South Carolina or the Trustees;
- making modifications to the corporate documents of the Diocese of South

Carolina or the Trustees including to their Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws;


- filing any documents with any governmental parties in the name of the Diocese of South Carolina or the Trustees including the South Carolina Secretary of State;
- creating or assuming business accounts with third parties in the name of the Diocese of South Carolina or the Trustees.
- and for such other relief as may be determined upon the hearing of this matter.

The grounds for this motion are that the movants will suffer immediate and irreparable injury if the Order is not granted all as is more fully stated and supported in the Memorandum in Support of this Motion, the Verified Complaint and in the Affidavits of James B.
